Chelsea and Westminster Hospital NHS Foundation Trust and Bristol Myers Squibb Pharmaceuticals Limited (BMS) on behalf of BMS-Pfizer Alliance entered into an agreement to deliver a collaborative working project. This project aimed to maximise the opportunity to identify patients at risk of atrial fibrillation (AF) through the deployment of a machine learning tool in development by BMS on behalf of BMS-Pfizer Alliance and referred to in the project as "Pulse AI", or the algorithm.

BMS on behalf of BMS-Pfizer Alliance's development of the machine learning tool was ceased through the duration of the project and as such, the objectives of the project could not be completed.

Therefore the collaborative working agreement was terminated effective 22nd July 2022.

This project was active from July 2021 and was terminated in July 2022.
