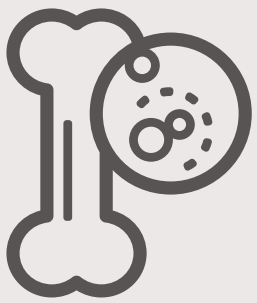


Myeloma

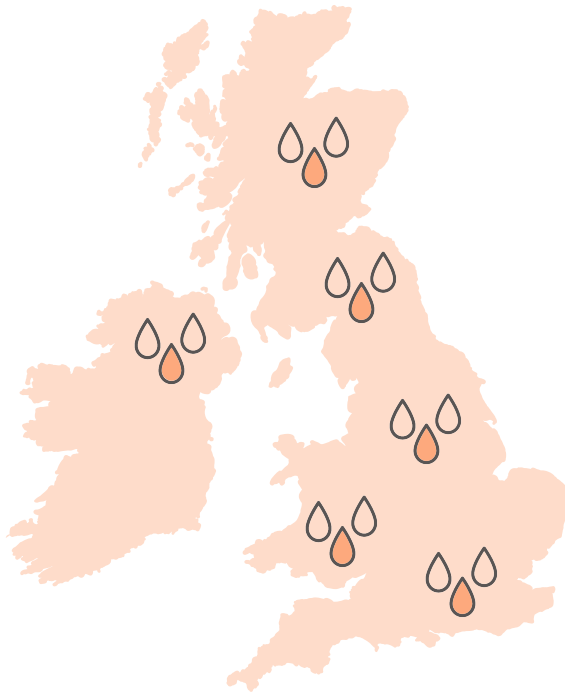
What is myeloma?



Myeloma is a type of blood cancer affecting white blood cells called **plasma cells**. It causes plasma cells to produce too many **abnormal antibodies** that cannot fight infection. Myeloma is often referred to as **multiple myeloma** because the **bone marrow** is usually affected in multiple places around the body.¹

UK prevalence

Approximately **6,000** people are diagnosed with **myeloma** each year (2016–2018)²



Myeloma accounts for **15%** of blood cancers & **2%** of all cancers³

It mainly affects people over the age of **65**³

Risk factors

It is not known exactly what causes **myeloma**, but factors considered to increase a person's risk include¹:



Age



Sex



Family history



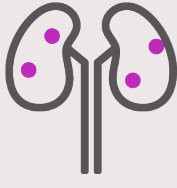
Ethnicity

Signs and symptoms

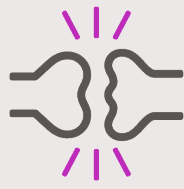
People with **myeloma** may experience a range of symptoms which can impact their **quality of life**. These may include⁴:



Fatigue



Kidney damage



Bone disease



Pain

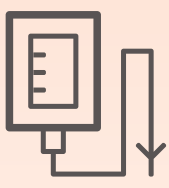


Recurring infection

Treatment options

Myeloma is a **relapsing-remitting cancer**, meaning there are periods where myeloma causes **symptoms** and needs to be treated and periods of **remission** where it does not require treatment.³

Treatment options include⁵:



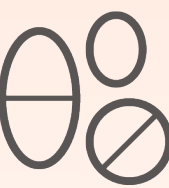
Chemotherapy



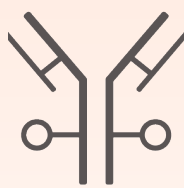
Other targeted drugs



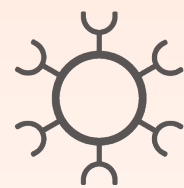
Stem cell transplant



Steroids



Immunotherapy (monoclonal antibodies)



Inhibitors (cancer growth blockers)
