“Termination Statement of Joint Working Project”

Bristol Myers Squibb (BMS) on behalf of BMS-Pfizer Alliance and South Tees Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust entered into an agreement to deliver a “Maximising the opportunity to detect, diagnose and treat patients with obesity and atrial fibrillation (AF) through implementation of a multi-disciplinary (MDT) based integrated care pathway for local patients” collaborative working project.

Due to organisational changes within NHS South Tees Hospital NHS Foundation Trust the parties agreed to terminate early as the project objectives could no longer be met. Therefore, the collaborative working agreement was terminated effective from February 2023.

The project originally commenced in January 2022 and was terminated in February 2023.

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
