Rationale for RFP	BMS has sponsored the lectureships in Organic Chemistry for over 30 years. BMS aims to continue to encourage excellence in education and in research in organic synthesis.
Criteria for selection	Institution must be a research PhD granting chemistry department and have an organic chemistry focused faculty and department. Location of University must be in the US.
Award information	The Lectureships are granted annually to institutions with synthetic organic chemistry departments. The \$4,000 grant is designed to provide funding towards a lectureship program.
Selection timing	We anticipate that we will complete the selection process by June 12 th , 2026.
