Goals for the Grants



Reduce access-to-care barriers in patient treatment

Bolster community outreach and education, patient support and care coordination, and collaboration between healthcare workers and patients



Foster diversity in the community health care worker and patient navigator workforce



Support community health care workers and patient navigators with training and service delivery programs

Leverage experts in healthcare navigation and members of the patient community to ensure equitable access care



Address societal and economic conditions that make up negative social determinants of health
