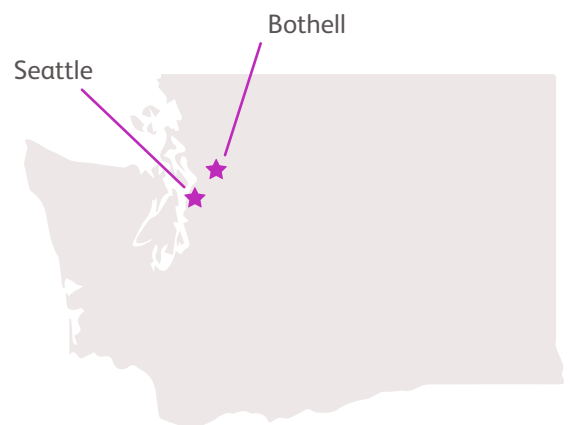


Washington

Our teams in **Seattle** and **Bothell** discover, develop, manufacture and commercialize therapies in immuno-oncology and cell therapy. We operate with the entrepreneurial spirit of a biotech start-up combined with the expertise, resources, infrastructure and global scale of a leading biopharma to advance novel treatments for cancer patients with precision and purpose.



Areas of Focus

Seattle is home to the Immuno-Oncology and Cell Therapy Thematic Research Center, a fundamental research and early development engine for **engineered cell-based therapies and biotherapeutics** aimed at harnessing the power of immune cells to enhance or restore the body's ability to fight cancer. Cell Therapy Technical Development and Operation teams also based in Seattle focus on developing the technologies and manufacturing platforms used to produce, test and deliver innovative cell therapy medicines from early-stage clinical studies through commercialization.

Bothell's state-of-the-art cell therapy manufacturing facility is equipped with cutting-edge technologies and highly trained manufacturing teams to produce engineered cell-based therapies for cancer patients. As the first Bristol Myers Squibb cell therapy manufacturing facility in operation, process innovations initiated by our teams have given rise to some of our newest technologies and manufacturing strategies being deployed across our growing global network of cell therapy manufacturing facilities.

Bristol Myers Squibb provides high-quality jobs for residents across the state and currently employs more than 1,240 employees* in Washington state, with a total payroll of \$368 million. [*As of October 2021]

Our commitment to Washington state means working to support and strengthen the communities in which we work and live.



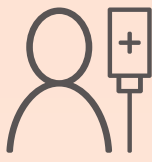
Local Community Support

Focus on Patients

Bristol Myers Squibb supports the Bristol Myers Squibb Foundation, an independent nonprofit whose mission is to promote health equity and to improve the health outcomes of populations disproportionately affected by serious diseases.

Over 250 grants were awarded totaling \$42 million across the U.S. in 2020.



Diversity and Inclusion

In 2020, Bristol Myers Squibb and the Bristol Myers Squibb Foundation each separately committed \$150 million over five years to help address health disparities, increase clinical trial diversity, expand supplier diversity, enhance employee giving and increase executive diversity in our workforce.



Supplier Diversity

In 2020, Bristol Myers Squibb spent \$662,000 with diverse suppliers in Washington state. Bristol Myers Squibb's Supplier Diversity Program is centered around an ethos of "Partnering with Purpose." The organization strives to champion economic empowerment, wealth creation and job creation in the community, while fostering inclusive innovation and a supply chain that reflects the company's values, its patients and the world.



Protecting the Environment

As we experienced significant business growth, our company also has been able to reduce operation-generated greenhouse gas emissions by more than 20% and water use by more than 10% over our 2015 baselines.



Product Donation

Bristol Myers Squibb helps patients through product donations to independent charitable organizations, including the Bristol Myers Squibb Patient Assistance Foundation, an independent nonprofit that assists financially needy patients who are uninsured or underinsured.

It provided a \$1.5 billion value of free medicine to 116,000 patients in the U.S. in 2020.
