

Introducing the Robert A. Winn Clinical Investigator Pipeline Program Students

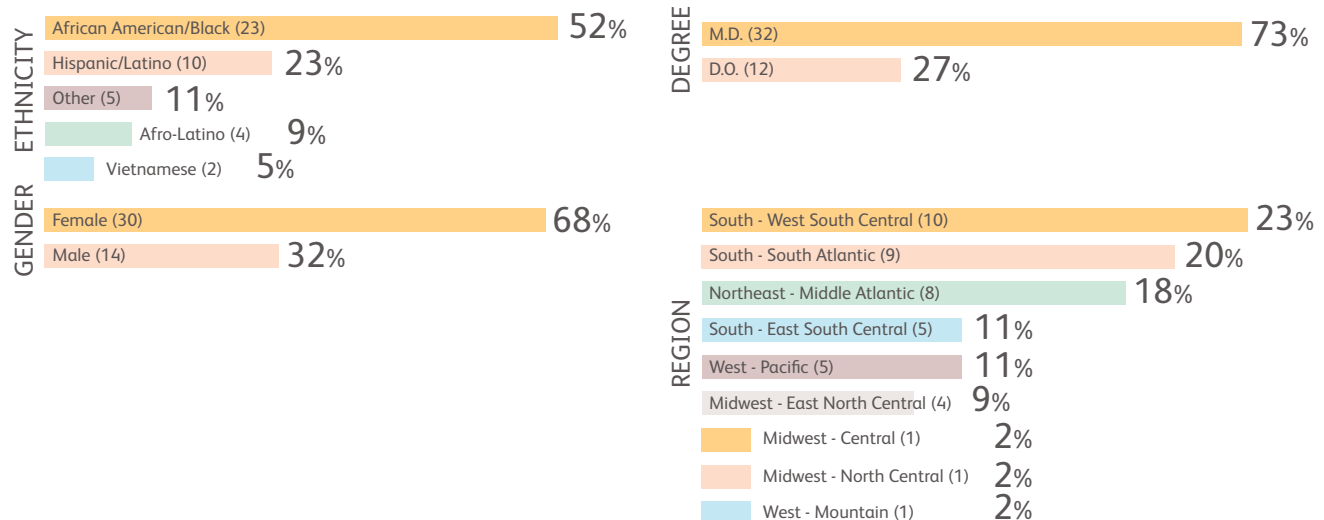
